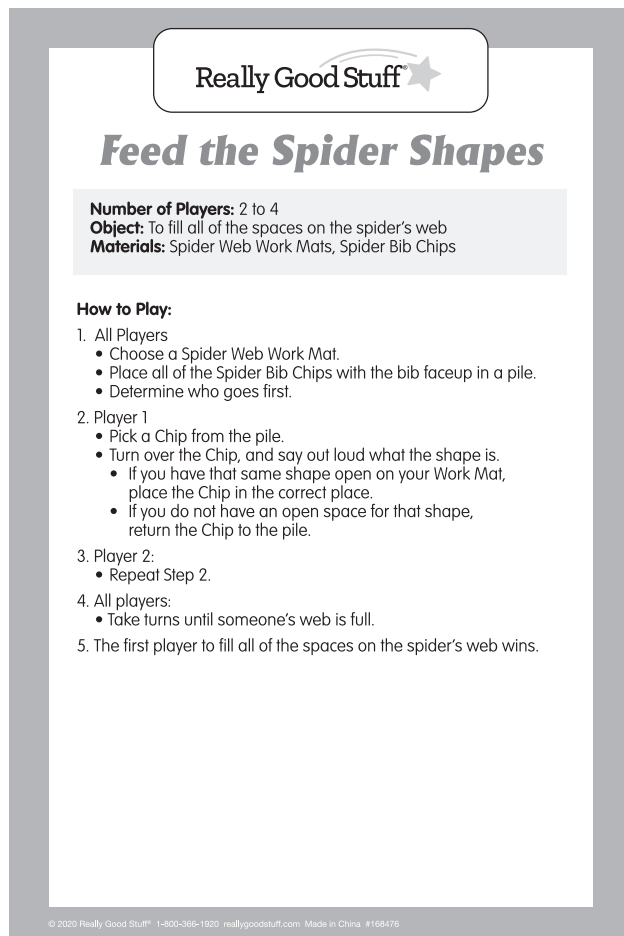
Choose a couple of students to model playing **Feed the Spider - Shapes Match** for the class. Explain the object of game and how to play it to the volunteers. With the rest of the class gathered around, encourage the volunteers to play the game. Showing students the *Center Task Card*, explain that it will be in the center with the game if they need to be reminded of how to play.

Center Task Card

Post the *Center Task Card* at the numeracy center where students will be able to see it easily. Remind students to refer to the shaded section at the top of the *Card* to be sure that they have all the needed materials.

Feed the Spiders Reproducible

Copy and distribute the *Feed the Spiders Reproducible* for everyone to use as practice, or use it as a follow-up for students who have completed the center. Explain that students are to identify the shapes along the top and draw them in the box next to the spider that is wearing the bib with that shape on it.
